It details a long summer journey taken from San Francisco to Colorado by her family and explores the relationship between Raina and her younger sister Ammara. Technical Raina Telgemeier presented a storyboard/sketch project to her sister three years before the publication of the novel, seeking Amar's consent to tell the story as Reina recalled it. Amara provided information about some vignettes and helped Raine develop a second project. The panels were painted by Brayden Lamb. The reception book received positive reviews. Maya Van Wagenen, a review for The New York Times described the story as One We All Lived Inconvenient yet Transcendental and added that it was a quick read as well as a fun one. Kirkus Reviews called him a winner, laughing out loud funny . and quietly seriously all at once; Later, in 2014, Kirkus named it one of the best children's books. According to the school in the magazine, the Ereiders will be very pleased. In 2014, Horn Book Magazine gave him a stellar review. In 2015, Telgemeier won the Eisner Award for Best Writer/Artist, citing Sisters.
